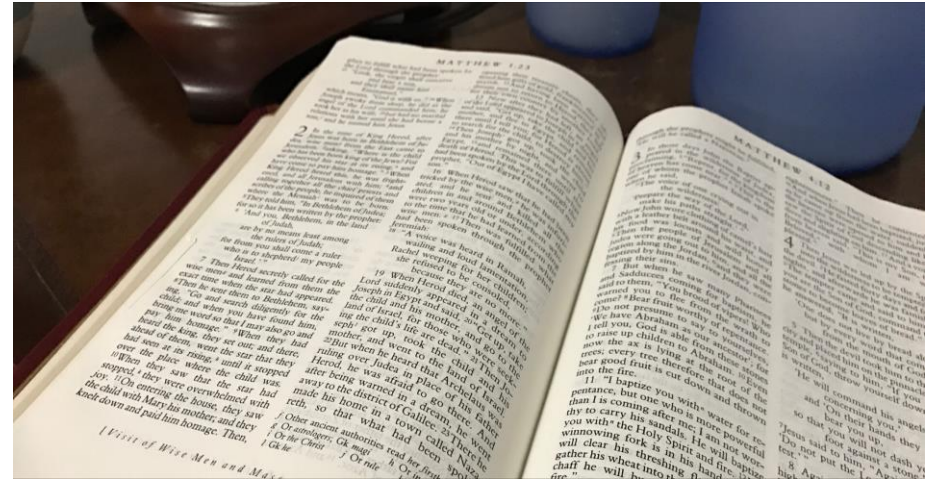
The Worship Committee will meet on Monday, August 14<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 p.m.
