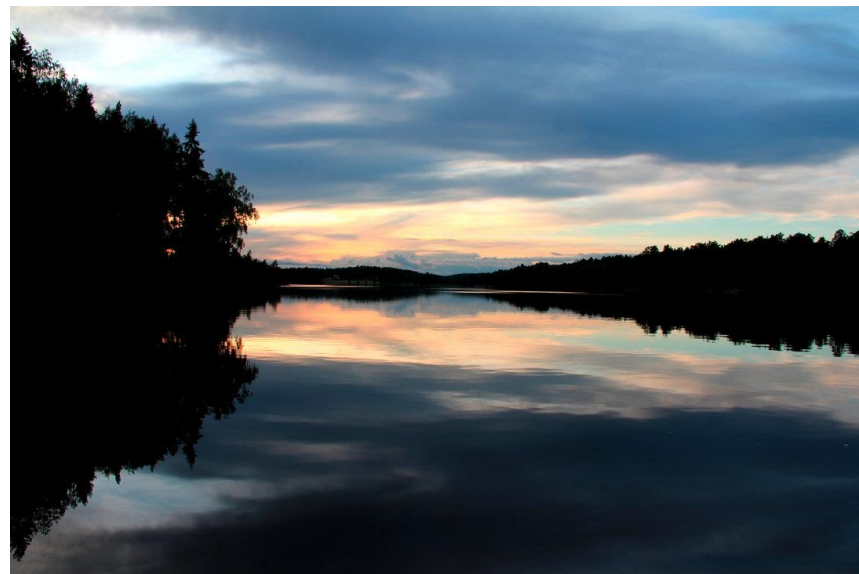
CLOTHING DRIVE
