Leader: We come from all places to gather at the Lord's Table.

Children & Youth: Who can come to this table?

Leader: Jesus invites all those who trust him to come to this table.

Great Prayer of Thanksgiving and the Lord's Prayer

One: The Lord be with you.

All: And also with you.

One: Lift up your hearts.

All: We lift them up to the Lord.

One: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

All: It is right to give our thanks and praise.

Children & Youth: Why do we give thanks at this table?

Leader: We give thanks for God's creation,
for making us in God's image.

We give thanks because God never gave up on us
even though we were not faithful to God.

We give thanks because when it was time,
God sent Jesus, God's child, to show God's love for us.

Children & Youth: How do we thank and praise God for all of this?

Leader: With all the faithful people of every time and place in the world we sing this song of God's glory.

Leader: Let us pray.

All: Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Words of Institution

Children & Youth: What do we remember at this table?

Leader: We remember Jesus, God's child:

All: Jesus healed the sick and restored sight to the blind;

Jesus welcomed strangers and ate with outcasts.

Dying on the cross, Jesus saved us from our sin,

Risen from the dead, Jesus gives us new life.

Children & Youth: Why do we eat bread at this table?

Leader: Jesus took bread, blessed it, broke it and gave it to his friends.

Children & Youth: Why do we drink from the cup at this table?

Leader: Jesus gave them the cup as the promise that our sins are forgiven.

He said, "This is my blood, poured out for you."

Children & Youth: But this is just everyday bread and grape juice.

Leader: Let us pray that the everyday bread and juice will become holy:
Gracious God, send your Holy Spirit to be with us and upon these your gifts
of bread and cup that the bread we break and the cup we bless may bring us
closer to Jesus and Jesus closer to us. Amen.
