There are some things to remember on a daily basis that helps us focus on living for God, for loving God and others. Focusing well and setting our hearts, minds, and spirits on seeking first the kingdom of God allows

for us to have more of what Christ wants us to have in life, the very things that are most important and that bless everything and everyone else in our lives.

Whether you are able to attend Ash Wednesday's service or not, remember every day with greater focus and purpose Jesus Christ and his love and mission for you and your life so that you may draw closer to the One who loves you, forgives you, empowers you, is proud of you, and will welcome you one day to heaven with the words, "Well done my good and faithful servant. Well done."


