Acceptable donations include: women's shoes, belts, handbags, small kitchen appliances, cookware, kitchenware, crafting items, and other household items and décor.

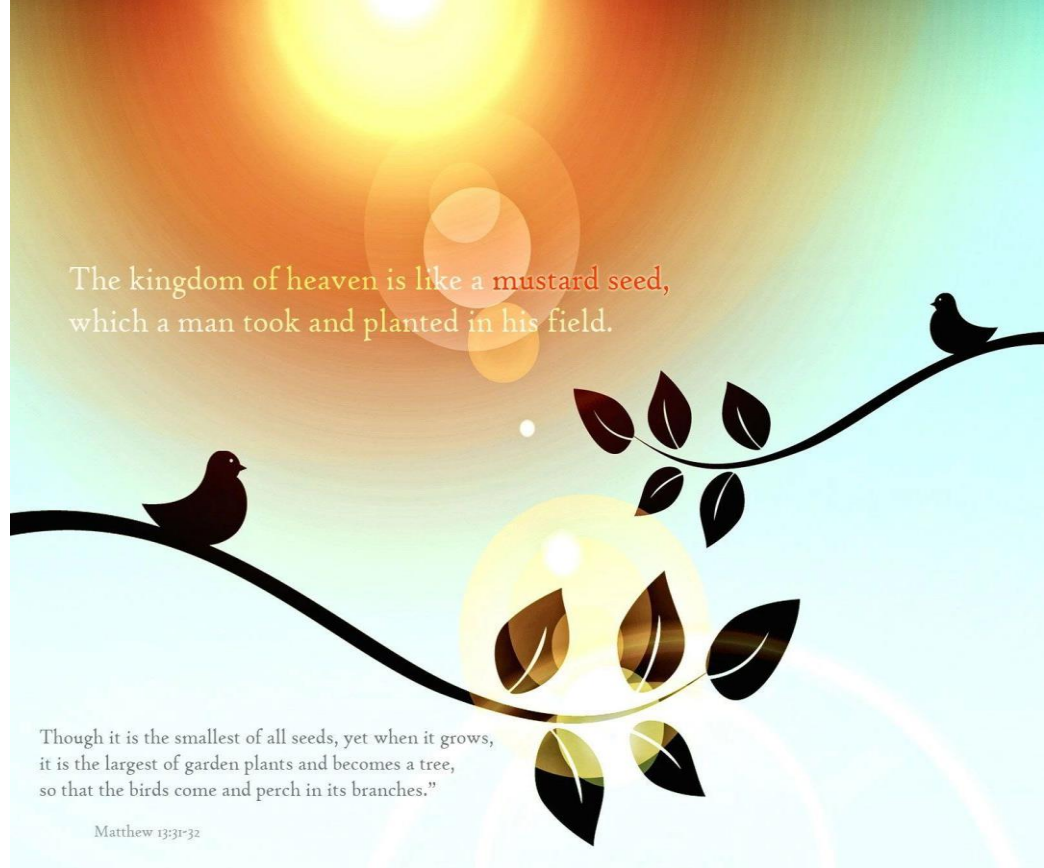
