MARCH STORY HOUR

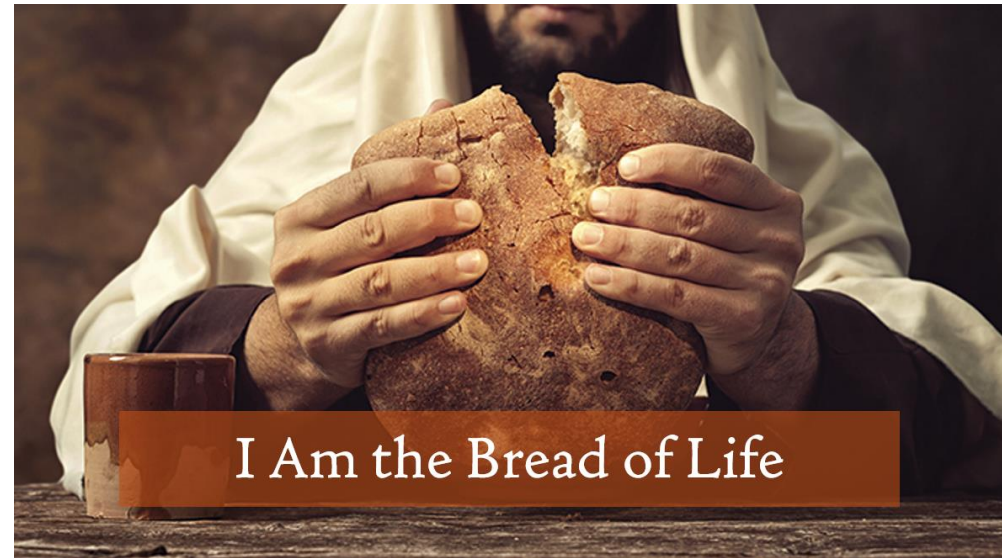
