RUMMAGE SALE

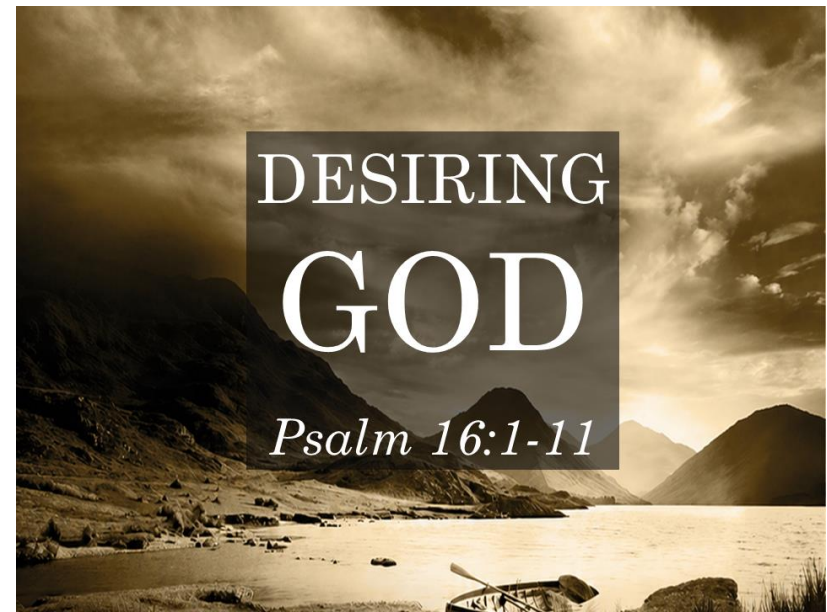
